### **NORTH CAROLINA PERMIT OFFICE NOW ALLOWING WEEKEND TRAVEL**

In the past, the North Carolina Oversize/Overweight Permit Office has allowed travel under permit on the weekends only in exceptional circumstances, such as when transporting an extraordinarily high or heavy load. Even then, weekend travel typically would be allowed only when the route to be traveled was in a heavily populated urban area, where the Permit Office deemed it in the best interests of public safety for the load to travel on the weekend instead of on a weekday.

Recently, the NC Permit Office has changed its position on weekend travel. Weekend travel now is allowable on virtually any load, as long as the carrier moving the load requests weekend travel along with the permit application.

If you have any special circumstances that would require your load to be moved on a weekend, please let us know at the time you book your move and we will make sure to take this into account when scheduling our truck and ordering the permit.
